REGISTERED LANDSCAPE ARCHITECTS AND REGISTERED LANDSCAPE ARCHITECTURAL CORPORATIONS IN THE STATE OF NORTH CAROLINA

- A. A copy of the seal to be used by registrants in accordance with Section 89A-2 is shown below.
- B. The seal will conform in size and format to the sample impression at the end of this bulletin, and shall have all of these components:
 - 1. (a) The certificate number shall be placed in the inner circle of the seal. Numbers for individual registered landscape architects consist only of digits. (Example: 15)
 - (b) Numbers for registered landscape architectural corporations must be preceded by the letter "C" followed by a dash. (Example: C-006)
 - 2. The inner circle shall contain around the periphery of the circle the words "Registered Landscape Architect" for individuals or the words "Registered Landscape Architectural Corporation" for corporations.
 - 3. The outer circle shall have the words "North Carolina" at the top of the circle. The words "North Carolina" shall be both preceded by and followed with a star.
 - 4. The outer circle shall have the name of the registered individual or the name of the registered landscape architectural corporation listed at the bottom of the circle. (Example: Individual: Richard C. Bell)
- C. The Board has ruled that the date of registration shall not be placed on the seal.
- D. No information other than that described in Section B shall be placed on the seal.
- E. The method of application of the seal to plans and specifications may be at the option of the registrant. A stamp, a metal impression or digitized seal may be used.
- F. Each Landscape Architect or each Landscape Architectural Corporation shall file immediately with the Board on letterhead, a sample impression of the seal which the individual or corporation proposes to use. The Board shall be notified of any changes made in the seal.
- G. As a Landscape Architect duly registered in the State of North Carolina, your support and active cooperation will be welcome at all times in the administration of this law and other problems of mutual professional interest.
